Home visit service - particularly useful for assistance with loop systems, doorbells, smoke alarms, or telephones.

Courses to enable individuals or groups to develop awareness and communication skills about Deaf and Deafblind people.

We have a Resource Centre at Greetwell Place in North Lincoln with drop-in sessions for people living in the area of Lincoln. We also provide services for people living in East and West Lindsey, South and North Kesteven, Boston, South Hollands and the Deepings.

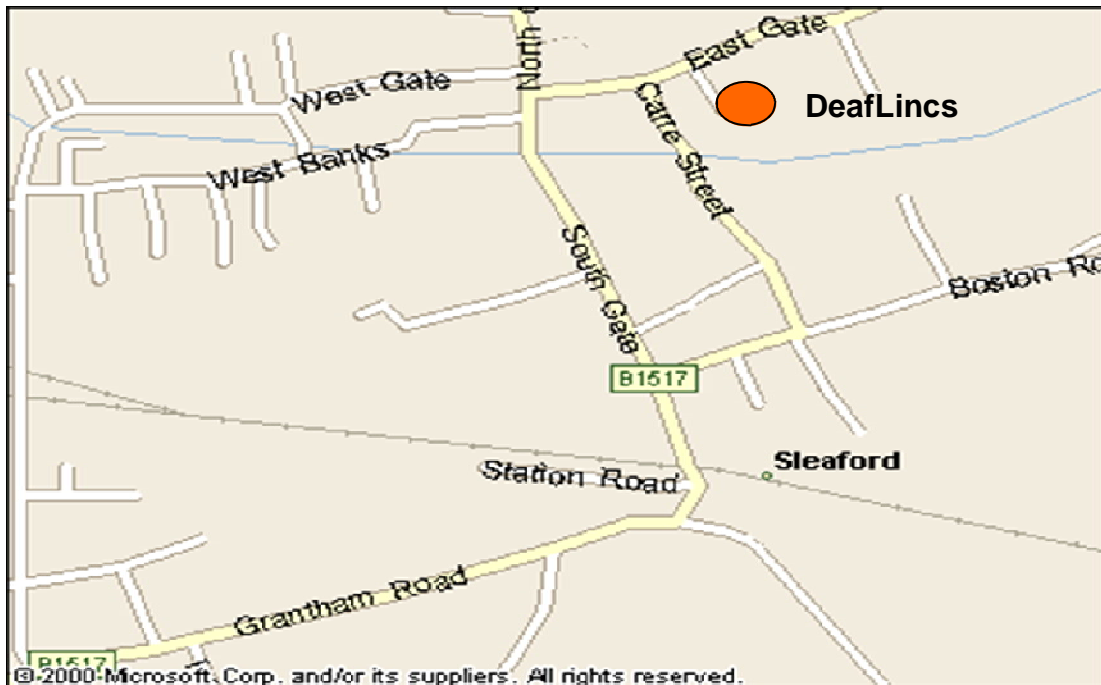
